


This document reviews how to access MILEARN State Assessment data using links embedded in MISTAR Q applications for staff, students and contacts with Parent Connect access.

Items of Note

- MILEARN must be implemented in the district for the assessment link to return results
- Simply adding the State Assessment link to Q Analysis menu or Parent/Student Connect modules will not enable this feature
- Clicking the link opens a new window and redirects the user to the MILEARN site
- Clicking the link also performs single sign-on functions so additional credentials management is not needed
- Contact MISTAR Support via the Service Desk to implement this feature or with questions on configuration or permissions set up


MILEARN State Assessment Data for Staff

1. Navigate to Analysis > State Assessment Data



MILEARN State Assessment Data from Parent or Student Connect


1. Login to Parent/Student Connect (Parents may need to select a specific student at login)



- a. From the Menu, expand the **Links** option to expand the selection on the right
- b. Click State Assessment Data link displayed at the right

MILEARN Redirect

1. Regardless of where the State Assessment Data link was clicked from, the following screen displays the MILEARN Screen in a new browser window



- a. Read the MILEARN Authorized Use notice as displayed
 - b. Select **I Agree** to continue to MILEARN and access assessment reports
